## Proclamation

**WHEREAS**, the Waikiki Beachboys Canoe Club (WBCC) was founded in 1973 by Kimo Makua, Ted Bush, Bob Nagaiami and Moku Kamaka to spread aloha spirit and traditional Hawaiian knowledge through canoe paddling outings on the south shore; and

**WHEREAS**, the aims of the club are to maintain and perpetuate Hawaiian culture through the promotion of Hawaiian water sports, to teach, train, and participate in the ancient art, craft and history of Hawaiian canoeing, and to provide means and facilities to foster the development and maintenance of strong and health minds; and

**WHEREAS**, the WBCC is a member club of Nā 'Ōhana O Nā Hui Wa'a racing association and has been highly successful in competitive outrigger canoe paddling races, including twice winning the prestigious Nā Wāhine O Ke Kai race from Molokai to O'ahu; and

**WHEREAS**, the club hosts the popular and prestigious Waikiki Invitational Regatta, a sprint race renowned for testing the canoe-surfing capabilities of the invitation-only competitors that draws a large number of spectators and contributes to the cultural education of residents and visitors alike; and

**WHEREAS**, the club is based at the Ala Wai Community Park hālau and trains primarily along the iconic south shore of O'ahu with its hut volunteering in the Waikiki community and contributing to the area's economy and tourism by providing paddling education to visitors; and

**WHEREAS**, the rich history of the club, its successes, and its efforts to perpetuate Native Hawaiian culture and water sports over a half a century are to be commended,

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK BLANGIARDI**, Mayor of the City and County of Honolulu, do hereby proclaim July 15, 2023, to be

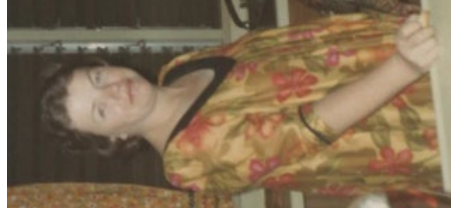
